3.4.3 Number of extension and outreach programs conducted by the institution through organized forums including NSS/NCC with involvement of community during the last five years

ACADEMIC YEAR: 2018-19

1. Campus Cleaning Programme

On July 4, 2018, Achhruram Memorial College's NSS Unit III and Unit II organized a Campus Cleaning Programme. This initiative aimed to promote cleanliness and hygiene within the college campus. A total of 63 students participated, actively engaging in cleaning activities to create a healthier and more pleasant environment for all. This event not only fostered a sense of responsibility among students but also emphasized the importance of maintaining a clean and green campus.

2. Workshop on Save The Girl Child

The NSS Unit III of Achhruram Memorial College conducted a Workshop on Save The Girl Child

on July 6, 2018. This workshop aimed to raise awareness about the significance of gender equality and the need to protect and empower girl children. With 78 students participating, the event included informative sessions and discussions, highlighting the social issues and challenges faced by girls in society.
